Modern slavery is a brutal form of organised crime in which people are treated as commodities and exploited for criminal gain.

The International Labour Organisation (ILO) estimates that 21 million men, women and children are working in conditions of modern slavery, including trafficked persons.

The vast majority of these people are in the supply chains of legitimate industries.
